

Ordinance No. 327-2024

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 9 of Ordinance No. 692-2021, passed October 11, 2021, relating to contracts and licenses necessary for ongoing mandatory environmental compliance for the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 692-2021, passed October 11, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Section 9. That the cost of any standard contract, software acquisition, or professional services contract or contracts authorized by this ordinance shall be paid from Fund ~~No. Nos.~~ Nos. 60 SF 001 and 60 SF 141, from the fund or funds to which are credited any grants received, and from any other funds approved by the Director of Finance. RQS 3001, RLA 2021-55.

Section 2. That existing Section 9 of Ordinance No. 692-2021, passed October 11, 2021, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
