

Ordinance No. 1005-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 6 of Ordinance No. 866-2021, passed October 18, 2021, relating to applying for and accepting a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security for the FY21 Port Security Grant Program for the purchase of a police boat.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 866-2021, passed October 18, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Section 6. That the costs of the contract or contracts authorized by this ordinance shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant proceeds accepted under this ordinance, ~~and the cash match, and any other funds approved by the Director of Finance.~~ (RQS 6002 RL 2021-84)

Section 2. That existing Section 6 of Ordinance No. 866-2021, passed October 18, 2021, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
