

Ordinance No. 214-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more contracts with Fire Force, Inc. for professional services necessary to provide the Airport rescue and firefighting personnel annual FAA certification training, for a period of one year, with three one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Fire Force, Inc. for professional services necessary to provide the Airport Rescue and Firefighting personnel annual FAA Part 139 certification training, on the basis of its proposal dated January 18, 2023, for the Department of Port Control for a period of one year, with three one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

Section 2. The contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund No. 60 SF 001, RQS 3001, RL 2023-4.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
