

Ordinance No. 260-2024

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more contracts with City Architecture, Inc. for the purpose of establishing and executing a public engagement coordination program, for the Office of Capital Projects, for a period of two years.

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects released a request for proposals for the purpose of establishing and executing a public engagement coordination program, for the Office of Capital Projects, for a period of two years and selected City Architecture, Inc. from the respondents; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Capital Projects is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with City Architecture, Inc. for the purpose of establishing and executing a public engagement coordination program, on the basis of its proposal dated January 20, 2023, for the Office of Capital Projects, for a period of two years.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Capital Projects may sign all documents that are necessary to obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the consultants selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. That the contract or contracts shall not exceed \$300,000, and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-0103-6926, RQS 0103, RL 2024-27.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
