SUBJECT: Ord. No. 791-2023 Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to employ one or

more professional consultants to provide software, equipment, installation, integration, and training to upgrade the video wall at the Emergency Operation Center, Office of Emergency Management, Department of Public Safety, for a term of one year, with two one-year options to renew,

exercisable by the Director of Public Safety

Ordinance No. 791-2023, if passed by Council, would authorize the Director of Public Safety to employ one or more professional consultants to provide software, equipment, installation, integration, and training to upgrade the video wall at the Emergency Operation Center, Office of Emergency Management, Department of Public Safety, for a term of one year, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Safety.

This legislation would authorize the upgrade of the EOC video wall and the associated components. The video wall is used during activations and training.

The Video Wall Upgrade project in the amount of \$900,000 will be funded through a general obligation bonds capital project.
