

Ordinance No. 468-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To supplement the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, by enacting new Section 143.05 relating to agreements for student intern and extern programs.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, are supplemented by enacting new Section 143.05 to read as follows:

Section 143.05 Agreements for Student Intern and Extern Programs

The Director of Human Resources, or other appropriate Director, is authorized to enter into one or more agreements with educational institutions and their students for the City to participate in student intern and extern programs, including, but not limited to, programs where the City receives reimbursements of wages or stipends paid to such students, programs where such students receive funds directly from their educational institution or another source, programs where the City provides a portion of the wages or stipends paid to such students, and programs where such students receive academic credit for interning at the City.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
