AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2020-27 with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to extend the term of the contract up to two years to provide additional services.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 556-2019, passed May 20, 2019, and Board of Control Resolution No. 551-19, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS 2020-27 with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to provide professional design and implementation services of an Asset Management Program for the Department of Port Control; and

WHEREAS, additional services are needed under that contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. 2020-27 with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. to extend the term of the contract up to two years to provide additional services under the contract.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract amendment shall not exceed \$650,000 per year and shall be paid from Fund No. 60 SF 001. (RQS 3001, RLA 2023-96)

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
