AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Health to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with URG Corporation and Met One Instruments for the purchase of proprietary samplers for up to four monitoring sites, for the Division of Air Quality, Department of Public Health.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities and services are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than URG Corporation and Met One Instruments. Therefore the Director of Public Health is authorized to make one or more written contracts with URG Corporation, quote dated October 24, 2023, and Met One Instruments, quote dated October 25, 2023, for the purchase of proprietary speciation sampling equipment on the basis of their quotes to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Air Quality, Department of Public Health. The contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. 15 SF 352. (RQS 5007, RLA 2023-131)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
