### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the Hispanic Police Officers Association for the Puerto Rican Expo for the public purpose of providing the a celebration of Puerto Rican arts, culture and educational programming through the use of Wards 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$35,250.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188 using the fund and project number from the following Ward:

<u>Section 5.</u> That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
