

THERE IS NO LEGAL OBJECTION TO THIS LEGISLATION IF AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the title, line 4, after "Progress" insert "to act as the City's agent"; strike lines 5, 6 and 7 in their entirety and insert: "finance costs for the acquisition, rehabilitation, remodeling or improvement of housing in the City, and further authorizing the"; and strike lines 12, 13, and 14 in their entirety and insert: "acquisition, construction, and rehabilitation of commercial properties, and act as the City's agent to provide acquisition, construction, rehabilitation or machinery and equipment costs for associated projects that will revitalize".
2. In the first whereas clause, line 3, after "live" insert "; and" and strike line 4 in its entirety.
3. In the fourth whereas clause, strike line 2 in its entirety and insert "reviewed in excess of 15 days and approved by the Housing Advisory Board on August 7, 2023, in compliance".
4. Insert a new fifth whereas clause to read as follows: "WHEREAS, in compliance with Ohio Constitution Article VIII, Section 13, this Council agrees to assist Cleveland Neighborhood Progress to revitalize commercial corridors for the public purpose of promotion of commerce, job retention and new job creation; and".
5. In Section 1, line 2, after "Progress" insert "to act as the City's agent"; and strike lines 3 and 4 in their entirety and insert "for the acquisition, rehabilitation, remodeling, or improvement of housing in the City for sale to individuals and families (the "Housing Renovation Project")".
6. In Section 2, at the end, insert "(RQS 8006 RL 2023-76)".
7. In Section 3, strike lines 4 and 5 in their entirety and insert: "construction and rehabilitation of commercial properties along commercial corridors of the City and to act as the City's agent to provide acquisition, construction, rehabilitation or machinery and equipment costs for associated projects that will".
8. In Section 4, at the end, insert "(RQS 9501 RL 2023-77)".
