

Ordinance No. 861-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Clerk of Council to enter into an agreement with Granicus, Inc. to renew or purchase software subscriptions for an integrated legislative management system for Cleveland City Council.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Clerk of Council is authorized to enter into an agreement with Granicus, Inc. to renew or purchase software subscriptions for an integrated legislative management system for Cleveland City Council. This agreement shall be entered into as of November 1, 2023 and shall terminate one (1) year thereafter on October 31, 2024, with two (2) options to renew, exercisable by the Clerk, for a term of one (1) year each. The cost of the first year of this agreement shall not exceed \$37,169.84 and shall be paid for from fund 11-006 and/or fund numbers 632000-01-010100.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
