Director of Finance.

Description: Legislation to authorize Director of MOCAP to enter into various agreements to facilitate the Bedrock Development Project (AKA

Cuvahoga Riverfront Masterplan).

The Cuyahoga Riverfront Development construction of roadway and bridge improvements including full depth pavement, drainage upgrades, installation of curb, sidewalk and driveways, including but not limited to the following streets:

- Huron Avenue,
- Superior Avenue,
- West Prospect Street,
- Ontario Street.
- Canal Road,
- Eagle Avenue,
- W. 3rd Street.
- **Factory Street**
- Stones Levee

The City of Cleveland also shall have the authority to purchase various construction and maintenance equipment, as required by the Bedrock Development project

- Hope memorial bridge and Cuyahoga river to the south, and;
- Carter Road and Robert Lockwood Drive to the west
