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Ordinance No. 1357-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. LS 2021*006 with Prospect International Airport Services Corporation for the lease of space located in the passenger terminal building at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport to support their wheelchair operations and other ancillary services for Delta Air Lines and other airlines.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 1330-2019, passed November 18, 2019, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. LS 2021*006 with Prospect International Airport Services Corporation ("Prospect") for the lease of space located in the passenger terminal building at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport to support their wheelchair operations and other ancillary services for Delta Air Lines and other airlines; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1330-2019 requires further legislation before exercising the second option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, for the use of the Leased premises, Prospect shall pay the City an annual fee as specified in the contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. LS 2021*006 with Prospect for the lease of space located in the passenger terminal building at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport to support their wheelchair operations and other ancillary services for Delta Air Lines and other airlines. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 1330-2019 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
