Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control (“Department”) is requesting authority to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC2021-07 with ADB Safegates America LLC for the requirements of equipment, parts, labor, and required services needed to maintain the airfield lighting control system, including labor and materials for repair and installation, if necessary, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The airfield lighting control system (ALCS) is used to control and monitor all airfield lighting equipment installed on the airfield and supports the efficient and safe maneuvering of all traffic on an airfield. The Department is required to maintain the airfield lighting systems in order to maintain compliance with FAA Part 139 regulations.

Ordinance 898-2020 provides that the first of the two one-year options to renew shall not be exercised without additional legislative authority. The Department is desirous of exercising the first of the one-year options for Contract No. RC2021-07.

Justification/Urgency:

These services are required to ensure compliance with FAA Part 139 requirements and ensures that the Department of Port Control maintains safe and secure runways at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department is requesting to exercise the first of the two one-year options to renew.

Anticipated Costs:

\$300,000 Annually
