LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:

This Grant will provide the Department of Public Works, Division of West Side Market, with professional services to design and conduct a composting pilot with wasted food generated by vendors at the West Side Market.

- 1. The purpose of this grant is to support the City of Cleveland's waste management to convert the current landfilled organic waste material to healthy compost that can support the carbon goals of the region.
- 2. Identify additional sites for community composting that could be support incentives to small businesses that adopt circular economy strategies consistent with the guidance provided by the Circular Cleveland Working Group that will be designated by December 1 2022.
