Contract Amendment

Purpose

- Amend Contract No. PS 2023*0018 under Ord. 1232-2022
- Change the name from James Corner Field Operations, LLC to Field Operations, LLC
- Provide for additional work needed to the plan related to:
 - Transportation planning related to the Connector project
 - 3D digital modeling and professional renderings
 - Community engagement and meetings
 - Conceptual drafts and scenario planning
 - Shore-core-shore concept development
- ~~Contract extension for an additional year~~ (allowed under Ord. 1232-2022 to expire 1/13/2025)

near the water. ~~~~~

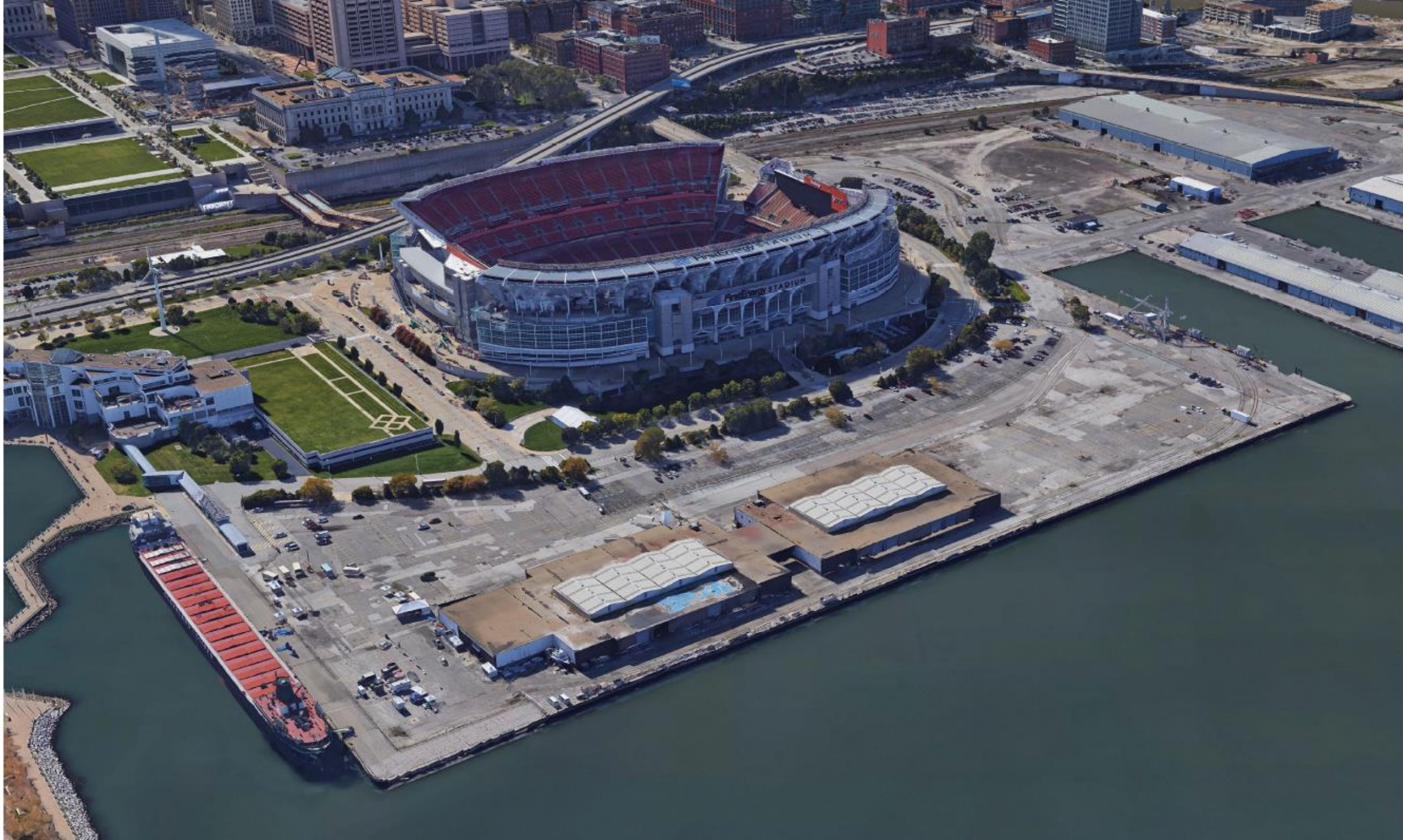




PechaKucha presenters wove personal and historical stories around themes related to the lakefront and water.
