SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 547-2024 Nominating and voting on who should serve on

Cuyahoga County's 9-1-1 Program Review Committee

DATE: June 3, 2024

Cuyahoga County maintains a 9-1-1 Plan in accordance with ORC Section 128.07. This Plan is for the implementation and operation of the countywide 9-1-1 system. Cuyahoga County is also required to maintain a county 9-1-1 Program Review Committee in accordance with ORC Section 128.06(B) which specifies the committee members.

The Cuyahoga County 9-1-1 Program Review Committee is a five member committee consisting of Cuyahoga County Executive Chris Ronayne, City of Cleveland Mayor Justin M. Bibb, City of Parma Mayor Timothy DeGeeter, Olmsted Township Trustee Lisa Zver, and a Mayors and City Managers Association Representative. The Mayors and City Managers Association Representative shall be selected by the majority of all of the legislative authorities of municipal corporations in Cuyahoga County.

If approved by Council, Ord. No. 547-2024 would nominate and vote for Mayor Kirsten Holzheimer-Gail of the City of Euclid to serve on Cuyahoga County's 9-1-1 Program Review Committee as the representative of all chief executive officers of all municipal corporations within Cuyahoga County, in accordance with ORC Section 128.06(B)(4).
