

Ordinance No. 1116-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS 2020-265 with HomeServe USA Corp. to provide optional protection plan and service contracts to residential water and sewer customers, for the Divisions of Water and Water Pollution Control, Department of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 1005-2019, passed September 30, 2019, the Director of Public Utilities entered into Contract No. PS 2020-265 with HomeServe USA Corp. to provide optional protection plan and service contracts to residential water and sewer customers that would cover repairs to their water service lines, sewer service lines, hot water heaters, and certain existing internal plumbing facilities, for the Divisions of Water and Water Pollution Control, Department of Public Utilities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1005-2019 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS 2020-265 with HomeServe USA Corp. to provide optional protection plan and service contracts to residential water and sewer customers that would cover repairs to their water service lines, sewer service lines, hot water heaters, and certain existing internal plumbing facilities, for the Divisions of Water and Water Pollution Control, Department of Public Utilities. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 1005-2019 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
