AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 905-2022 and Section 3 of Ordinance No. 906-2022, passed September 19, 2022, relating to allocating a portion of the City's Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds for the agreements with Child Care Resource Center of Cuyahoga County, dba Starting Point, to assist with the Early Childhood Recovery Initiative.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 905-2022, passed September 19, 2022, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the cost of all agreements authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed \$2,668,750 \$2,168,750 and shall be paid from the Fund Payment, Fund No. 01-001-9997, Fund No. 15 SF 190, and from any other funds approved by the Director of Finance. (RQS 0114, RLA 2022-56)

Section 2. That existing Section 3 of Ordinance No. 905-2022, passed September 19, 2022, is repealed.

Section 3. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 906-2022, passed September 19, 2022, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the cost of all agreements authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed \$1,888,750 \$2,388,750 and shall be paid from the Fund Payment, Fund No. 01-001-9997, Fund No. 15 SF 190, and from any other funds approved by the Director of Finance. (RQS 0114, RLA 2022-52)

Section 4. That existing Section 3 of Ordinance No. 906-2022, passed September 19, 2022, is repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
