AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Authorizing the Clerk of Council to enter into an Agreement with Guy Gadowski for various professional financial consulting and auditing services for Cleveland City Council.

FOR PASSAGE
January 23, 2023

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Clerk of Council is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Guy Gadowski, for various professional financial consulting and auditing services for Cleveland City Council including, but not limited to, review of the Mayor's 2023 budget estimate, monthly budget reviews and analyses, briefings to the Council President and designees, and any other financial advisory services as may be directed by Council President or designee. This Agreement shall begin as of January 1, 2023, and continue through June 30, 2023. The Director of Finance shall certify the Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$30,000, from Fund 01, Dept. 0101 Subfund 001 Object Code 6320.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
