AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 135.47 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 967-91, passed June 17, 1991, relating to Emergency Medical Service clinical agreements.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 135.47 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 967-91, passed June 17, 1991, is amended to read as follows:

Section 135.47 Emergency Medical Service Clinical Agreements

The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into clinical agreements with Cuyahoga Community College, other governmental agencies, and the various area hospitals to establish and maintain emergency medical technology, EMT and paramedic continuing education, observation, and paramedic and EMT training programs.

Section 2. That existing Section 135.47 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 967-91, passed June 17, 1991, is repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
