

Ordinance No. 939-2020

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend the title and Section 8 of Ordinance No. 485-2020, passed June 3 2020, relating to authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept the Operation Relentless Pursuit Program grant to add a contract with KG Automotive, LLC for the purpose of used vehicles which will be used for the grant purposes.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the title and Section 8 of Ordinance No. 485-2020, passed June 3, 2020, are amended to read as follows:

An Emergency Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Operation Relentless Pursuit Program; authorizing the purchase by one or more requirement contracts of materials, equipment, supplies, or services needed and authorizing the director to enter into one or more contracts with various agencies or entities to implement the grant; and authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into contract with KG Automotive, LLC for the purchase of used vehicles.

Section 8. That the costs of the contract or contracts authorized by this ordinance shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant proceeds accepted under this ordinance. RQS 6002, RL 2020-110

Section 2. That the existing title and Section 8 of Ordinance No. 485-2020, passed June 3, 2020, are repealed.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 485-2020, passed June 3, 2020, is supplemented by adding new Section 4a. to read as follows:

Section 4a. That this Council determines that the within commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than KG Automotive, LLC aka Ken Ganley Chrysler Dodge Jeep Ram (“Ken Ganley”). Therefore the Director of Public Works is authorized to make one or more written contracts with Ken Ganley on the basis of its proposal dated November 25, 2020, in an amount up to \$250,000 for the purchase of used vehicles, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Motor Vehicle Maintenance, Department of Public Works.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
