

Ordinance No. 337-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 1084-2021, passed November 22, 2021, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into an agreement with Camp Journey or with its Fiscal Agent, Concerned Citizens Community Council, for the Salaam Community Empowerment Farm and Training Center Program through the use of Ward 4 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 1084-2021, passed November 22, 2021, are hereby amended to read as follows:

Authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into an agreement with Camp Journey or with its fiscal agent ~~Burton, Bell, Carr Development, Inc,~~ Concerned Citizens Community Council, for the Salaam Community Empowerment Farm and Training Center Program through the use of Ward 4 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Camp Journey or with its fiscal agent ~~Burton, Bell, Carr Development, Inc.~~ Concerned Citizens Community Council, for the Salaam Community Empowerment Farm and Training Center Program for the public purpose of providing education in urban farming, food and nutrition and workforce training to Cleveland residents through the use of Ward 4 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188 using the fund and project number from the following Ward:

Section 2. That the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 1084-2021, passed November 22, 2021, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
