**SUBJECT:** Ordinance No. 674-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for the FY 18 Port Security Grant Program; authorizing the acquisition of licenses; and authorizing the purchase and installation of a maritime radar security system, including associated equipment, maintenance and support for a period of three years

**Purpose:**

Ordinance No. 674-2020, if passed by Council, will authorize the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept the FY18 Port Security Grant Program. This grant will fund the purchase and installation of a maritime radar system.

The grant will reimburse the city for the cost of installing maritime radar equipment, for the purchase of computers for monitoring the radars, and for software and maintenance fees.

**Expenses to be Reimbursed:**

Equipment:	\$ 385,000 (radar system and computers)
Contractual:	<u>\$ 278,200</u> (Installation of radar equipment, software and maintenance)
Total:	\$ 663,200

Grant Award:	\$ 497,400
Matching Funds:	<u>\$ 165,800</u>
Total Project Amount:	\$ 663,200
