

Ordinance No. 764-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2021-217 with Team Hallahan LLC for a one-year extension to continue to assist the Department of Port Control with airport-related federal agencies and issues.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 434-2021, passed July 14, 2021, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS 2021-217 with Team Hallahan LLC to assist the Department of Port Control with airport-related federal agencies and issues, for a period of one year, with one option to renew for an additional one-year period; and

WHEREAS, additional services are necessary under this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2021-217 with Team Hallahan LLC for a one-year extension to continue to assist the Department of Port Control with airport-related federal agencies and issues. All other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain the same.

Section 2. That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the cost of the amendment shall not exceed \$96,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 60 SF 001. (RQS 3001, RL 2023-70)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
