

Ordinance No. 629-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Health to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2023-116 with Ronald K. White, dba The Transparency Program, Inc. to continue to provide Fatherhood services to participants in the MomsFirst Program.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 254-2023, passed April 3, 2023, the Director of Public Health entered into Contract No. PS 2023-116 with Ronald K White, dba The Transparency Program to continue to provide Fatherhood Services to participants in the MomsFirst Program for a period one year; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to Contract No. PS 2023-116 is necessary to provide increased salaries and added fringe benefits; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Health is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2023-116 with Ronald K White, dba The Transparency Program to provide increased salaries and added fringe benefits for up to one year. All other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain the same.

Section 2. That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3 That the cost of the amendment shall not exceed \$20,400 for a total of \$100,400 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-5008-6380, RQS 5008, RLA 2023-28.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
