AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 497-2020, passed June 17, 2020, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Health to enter into agreement with the National Kidney Foundation for the 2020 Virtual Kidney Walk through the use of Ward 9 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 497-2020, passed June 17, 2020, are hereby amended to read as follows.

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of ~~Community Development~~ Public Health to enter into agreement with the National Kidney Foundation for the 2020 Virtual Kidney Walk through the use of Ward 9 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of ~~Community Development~~ Public Health is hereby authorized to enter into agreement effective February 1, 2020, with the National Kidney Foundation for the 2020 Virtual Kidney Walk for the public purpose of providing public education on kidney disease prevention to residents residing in the city of Cleveland.

Section 2. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 497-2020, passed June 17, 2020, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
