

Ordinance No. 1015-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
Authorizing the Director of Public Works to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for its Urban Canopy Restoration Grant Program.

FOR PASSAGE
October 3, 2022

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works (“Director”) is authorized to apply for and accept a grant in the estimated amount of \$25,000 from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (“ODNR”) for ODNR’s Urban Canopy Restoration Grant Program; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant; and that the funds are appropriated for the purchase and planting of trees in the right of way between November 1, 2022, through December 31, 2023, the maintenance of which will be under existing arrangements in the Department of Public Works, as described in the Legislative Summary contained in the file identified below.

Section 2. That the Legislative Summary for this ODNR grant, **File No. 1015-2022-A**, which is made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten, has been approved and any subsequent need for changes shall require additional legislative authority. The ODNR grant will require a one-to-one cash match by the City of Cleveland, the matching funds of which will be paid from Fund No. 01-0112-6320. (RQS 0112, RLA 2022-77)

Section 3. That, under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the Director may make purchases through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies to expend the grant funds. The Director, working in conjunction with the Office of Sustainability, may sign all documents and do all things that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through the cooperative process with other governmental agencies. The contracts shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited any grant funds accepted under this ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
