

Ordinance No. 692-2020

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into one or more contracts with Avail Forensics for the acquisition of software and licenses for the Pathfinder Turn-Key Solution, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety; and authorizing the director to enter into an agreement with the Federal Bureau of Investigation to reimburse the City for expenses related to the City's acquisition of the software and licenses.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Avail Forensics for the acquisition of software and five licenses for the Pathfinder Turn-Key Solution, for a three-year period, on the basis of its quotation dated August 11, 2020, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI"), to reimburse the City for its cost of acquiring the software and five licenses for the Pathfinder Turn-Key Solution, for a three-year period. The Director of Public Safety is authorized to receive and accept the reimbursement on behalf of the City.

Section 3. That the agreement shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 4. That the cost of the contract with Avail Forensics shall not exceed \$150,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-6002-6397, RQS 6002, RL 2020-75.

That the reimbursement from the FBI shall not exceed \$150,000 and shall be deposited into a fund or funds approved by the Director of Finance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
