

Ordinance No. 270-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more contracts with SoundCom Corp. for professional services necessary to provide and install a digital public address system at Burke Lakefront Airport, including appurtenances, and for maintenance, training, and support for a period of one year, for the Division of Airports, Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with SoundCom Corp. for professional services necessary to provide and install a digital public address system at Burke Lakefront Airport, including appurtenances, and for maintenance, training, and support for a period of one year, on the basis of its proposal dated September 24, 2021. The contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund Nos. 60 SF 001, 60 SF 104, 60 SF 106, and 60 SF 141, RQS 3001, RL 2022-9.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
