### Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting through the U.S. Coast Guard, for the shared use of a portion of City-owned Lot 10, located immediately south of the US. Coast Guard facility's south gate situated at 1089 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street, for a period of five years with one five-year option to renew, exercisable by additional legislative authority.

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#### **Background/Purpose:**

The purpose of the agreement is to allow the U.S. Coast Guard and its agents secondary access and emergency access for the ingress and egress of a parcel of land which is a portion of Lot 10, when East 9<sup>th</sup> Street is closed for special events, or for vehicles with large turning diameters that cannot make U-turns to exit the East 9<sup>th</sup> Street gate.

#### **Justification/Urgency:**

The lease is needed by the U.S. Coast Guard for secondary access to the U.S. Coast Guards facility's south gate, situated at 1089 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Anticipated Cost:** N/A

#### **Schedule or Term of Contract:**

The Department is requesting a term of five years with one five-year option to renew, exercisable by additional legislative authority.
