

Ordinance No. 294-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To supplement the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, by enacting new Section 129.231 relating to the purchase of food and beverages for the Department of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, are supplemented by enacting new Section 129.231 to read as follows:

Section 129.231 Purchase of Food and Beverages for Department of Public Utilities

(a) The Director of Public Utilities is authorized to expend funds in order to provide food and non-alcoholic beverages for the following:

- (1) Engagement, informational, or learning programs and events for the community sponsored by the Department of Public Utilities;
- (2) Informational or learning programs and events for Department of Public Utility employees;
- (3) Emergency operations or other events requiring Department of Public Utility employees to work overtime or provide coverage outside of the normal working conditions to ensure uninterrupted utility services provided by the divisions; and
- (4) Department of Public Utility programs and events for employees and/or non-employees in connection with and in furtherance of the department's objectives.

(b) The total amount of funds expended under this section shall not exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) per year.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
