

Ordinance No. 1115-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC 2021-35 with AVO/Multi-Amp Corp. dba Megger to provide electrical test equipment and labor and materials necessary to maintain or repair electrical test equipment for the Division of Cleveland Public Power, Department of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 376-2020, passed June 17, 2020, the Director of Public Utilities entered into Contract No. RC 2021-35 with AVO/Multi-Amp Corp. dba Megger to provide the City's requirements of electrical test equipment and labor and materials necessary to maintain or repair electrical test equipment, including training when necessary, for the Division of Cleveland Public Power, Department of Public Utilities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 376-2020 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC 2021-35 with AVO/Multi-Amp Corp. dba Megger to provide the City's requirements for an additional year of electrical test equipment and labor and materials necessary to maintain or repair electrical test equipment, including training when necessary, for the Division of Cleveland Public Power, Department of Public Utilities. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 376-2020 to exercise this option. (RQN 2004, RL 2022-45)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
