Ordinance No. 1299-2019

The Department of Human Resources is seeking approval for the 2019-2022 Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Cleveland Patrolmen's Association (CPPA) Non-Civilian and to amend Section 56 of the Citywide Payband Ordinance.

WAGES

First Year: 2.0 % wage increase retroactive to April 1, 2019
Second Year: 2.0 % wage increase effective April 1, 2020
Third Year 2.0 % wage increase effective April 1, 2021

Section 56. Cleveland Police Patrolmen's Association (CPPA) Non Civilian

The annual salaries of persons appointed to the following ranks of the patrol officer shall be fixed by the appointing authority within the limits established in the following schedules:
