EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to purchase and/or rent by one or more requirement contracts heavy-duty equipment and other equipment with operators for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, for a period of two years, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to purchase and/or rent heavy-duty equipment and other equipment with operators, to assist with maintaining runway safety, by keeping areas free of ruts, humps, standing water, depressions, and accumulations of snow and ice. Each area must be capable of supporting the passage of aircraft and other equipment. Equipment and operators will also be utilized for construction projects and ongoing maintenance requirements on airport property.

Scope of Work:

To provide heavy-duty equipment with operators and other equipment for FAA Part 139 work, construction projects, and other maintenance requirements for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, on an as needed basis, as determined by the Department of Port Control.

Justification/Urgency:

These services are required in order to ensure the Department of Port Control maintains and repairs the various facilities and surrounding grounds at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront Airports. These services will also augment the Department's capabilities in the event of an emergency.

Anticipated cost:

\$375,000 annually

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department of Port Control is requesting a term of two years, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.
