EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC2020-051 with Fabrizi Recycling Inc. for heavy-duty equipment and other equipment with operators for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is required to under FAA Part 139 subpart D to maintain runway safety areas free of ruts, humps, standing water and depressions. Each safety must be capable under dry conditions of supporting the occasional passage of aircraft and other equipment.

Scope of Work:

To provide heavy-duty equipment with operators and other equipment for FAA Part 139 work, construction projects and other maintenance requirements for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, on an as needed basis, as determined by the Department of Port Control in its sole discretion.

Justification/Urgency:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the procurement by one or more requirement contracts for heavy-duty equipment with operators and other equipment for the various divisions of the department of Port Control for a period of two-years with two one year options. The current contract for heavy-duty equipment with operators will expire August 8th, 2022.

Anticipated cost: The anticipated cost for heavy-duty equipment with operators is approximately \$625,000 for two remaining option years.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department of Port Control is requesting to exercise the first of the one year options to renew.
