Dear Clerk Britt:

The purpose of this letter is to apprise your office that Pennrose Holdings, LLC plans to be the general partner of a residential rental development located in or within a one-half mile radius of your political jurisdiction, and will submit an application to utilize the multifamily funding programs of the Ohio Housing Finance Agency (OHFA) for the development of this property.

The Warner and Swasey redevelopment will be a dynamic mixed-used, mixed-income, historic adaptive reuse of a former manufacturing plant into a vibrant community providing affordable housing and office space oriented to workforce development. The project will include 140 new affordable housing units.

The development team is currently applying to OHFA for 9% Family LIHTCs for 56 affordable housing units. OHFA has already allocated Low-Income Housing Tax Credits for the senior component of this project, which includes 56 units; the remaining 28 units will be workforce units. The ground floor of the existing buildings will house approximately 20,000 SF of office space targeted towards organizations with a focus on technology and manufacturing with an emphasis on workforce development and supportive service programs which create opportunities for residents and the community at large.

The proposed development will be financed with a first mortgage, Low-Income Housing Tax Credit equity, Historic Tax Credit equity, City of Cleveland funds, HDAP consisting of Ohio Housing Trust Funds or National Housing Trust Funds, other OHFA resources, and other State, County, and Private funding.

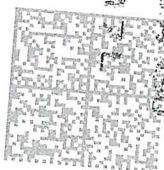
