

Ordinance No.1174-2025

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To change the name of a portion of East 159th Street, extending northerly, from Lake Shore Boulevard to Euclid Beach Boulevard.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That, notwithstanding and as an exception to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cleveland, 1976, the name of a portion of East 159th Street, extending northerly, from Lake Shore Boulevard, shall be changed to Euclid Beach Boulevard.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
