

Ordinance No. 1078-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more agreements with eligible City consultants to rent various types of specialized City-owned engineering equipment for the purpose of gathering data for the benefit of the City, for periods not to exceed six months, until January 1, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Department of Port Control has procured specialized engineering equipment for gathering data; and

WHEREAS, the Department desires to make this equipment available to consultants to allow for the continuity of the data stream because the same equipment will be used, thus eliminating the use of re-formatting programs and possible data loss; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more agreements with eligible City consultants to rent specialized City-owned engineering equipment for the purpose of gathering data for the benefit of the City, for periods not to exceed six months, until January 1, 2022.

Section 2. That the proceeds from the rental agreements shall be deposited into a fund designated by the Director of Finance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
