LEGISLATIVE REQUEST - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
ORDINANCE NO. 16-2022

Purpose: The U.S. Department of the Treasury issued Reallocation Guidance for the Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA1) program under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, on October 4, 2021. A Request for Reallocated Funds was submitted by the City of Cleveland. The Treasury approved the City of Cleveland’s request in the following amount: \$2,886,785.49.

Program Description: Authorizing the Director of Community Development to accept funding from the United States Treasury Department for purposes of implementing the Emergency Rental Assistance program established under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021; and authorizing contracts to implement.

Award Amount: \$2,886,785.49
