AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with MD Helicopters, LLC for the purchase of labor and materials needed to convert two helicopters, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities and services are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than MD Helicopters, LLC. Therefore the Director of Public Safety is authorized to make one or more written contracts with MD Helicopters, LLC, for the purchase of labor and materials needed to convert two helicopters from Model MD500E to Model MD530FF helicopters, including but not limited to, parts, components, and services for engine upgrades, and to provide additional labor and materials needed for performance, safety, reliability, and compatibility compliance, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety. The cost of this ordinance shall be approximately \$3,590,997 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 400. (RQS 0117, RL 2021-78)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
