

Ordinance No. 596-2026

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 2002 PS 2024-0299 with One Call Concepts Utility Locating Service, Inc., to provide professional services necessary for utility locating and marking underground infrastructures and other related services, for the various Divisions of the Department of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Section 129.294 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, the Director of Public Utilities entered into Contract No. CT 2002 PS 2024-0299 with One Call Concepts Utility Locating Service, Inc., to provide utility location and marketing underground infrastructure services for the various Divisions of the Department of Public Utilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 129.294 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 2002 PS 2024-0299 for an additional year with One Call Concepts Utility Locating Service, Inc., to provide professional services necessary for utility locating and marking underground infrastructures and other related services, including not limited to reviewing maps, documents, and/or ArcGIS files, for the various Divisions of the Department of Public Utilities. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Section 129.294 to exercise this option. (RQS 2002, RL 2026-21)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
