AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Withdrawing objection to the renewal of a D1, D2, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit at 4818-22 Memphis Avenue, and repealing Resolution No. 945-2025 objecting to said renewal.

WHEREAS, this Council objected to the renewal of a D1, D2, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit to H.I.M. Inc., DBA: Memphis Tavern, 4818-22 Memphis Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44144, Permit No. 3845983, by Resolution No. 945-2025, adopted by the Council on August 13, 2025; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the renewal of a D1, D2, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit to H.I.M. Inc., DBA: Memphis Tavern, 4818-22, Cleveland, Ohio 44144, Permit No. 3845983, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 945-2025, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
