

Ordinance No. 99-2022

(by departmental request)**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into one or more agreements with Case Western Reserve University for professional services necessary to continue implementation of a data collection and analysis process, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of one year with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Safety.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 1524-2019, passed December 2, 2019, the Director of Public Safety entered into Contract No. PS 2020-070 with Case Western Reserve University to provide professional services implementing a data collection and analysis process, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, the department requires continuation of substantially the same services as rendered under Contract No. PS 2020-070 in order to fulfill requirements of the Settlement Agreement entered into between the City of Cleveland and the United States Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into one or more agreements with Case Western Reserve University for professional services necessary to continue implementation of a data collection and analysis process, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of one year with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Safety.

Section 2. That the agreement or agreements shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the cost of the agreement or agreements authorized above shall not exceed \$250,000.00 per year and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-6012-6380.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
