DIVISION: Recreation

ORDINANCE NO: 305-2024

Participants remain engaged during the summer with fun, safe, and constructive team pursuits, while meeting new friends and learning about the sports of baseball and girls fast-pitch softball.

TERM: June 3, 2024 through July 31, 2024
