

Ordinance No. 1081-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2011-214 with Tyler Technologies, Inc. fka New World Corporation to provide mobile field reporting modules to enhance the new Law Enforcement Record Management System; and to extend the term of the contract until June 30, 2018.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2011-214 with Tyler Technologies, Inc. fka New World Corporation to provide mobile field reporting modules to enhance the new Law Enforcement Record Management System ("LERMS"), to implement and provide other services needed under the new Record Management System, and to extend the term of the contract until June 30, 2018. All other terms and conditions contained in the contract shall remain the same.

Section 2. That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the costs of the contract amendment shall not exceed \$38,760 and shall be paid from Fund No. 11 SF 006, Request No. RQS 6001, RL 2017-89.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
