

Ordinance No. 225-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Consenting and approving the issuance of a permit for The Towpath 10-10 Walk/Run, on June 16, 2023, managed by Hermes Sports & Events.

FOR PASSAGE
February 13, 2023

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That pursuant to Section 411.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio 1976, this Council consents to and approves the holding of The Towpath 10-10 Walk/Run, on June 16, 2023, managed by Hermes Sports & Events; Jefferson Avenue Runner Crossing: 5K, 10K, and 10 Mile runners are initially running South on bike trail and will cross Jefferson Avenue, all race distances will return and cross this intersection a second time heading back north; Holmden Avenue Runner Crossing: 10K and 10 Mile runners are initially running South on bike trail and will cross Holmden Avenue, all race distances will return and cross this intersection a second time heading back North; Jennings/Harvard Runner Crossing: 10 Mile runners are initially running South on bike trail and will cross Jennings Road/Harvard Avenue. 10 Miler runners will return and cross this intersection a second time heading back North; provided that the applicant sponsor shall meet all the requirements of Section 411.05 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976. Streets may be closed as determined by the Chief of Police and safety forces as may be necessary in order to protect the participants in the event. Said permit shall further provide that the City of Cleveland shall be fully indemnified from any and all liability resulting from the issuance of the same, to the extent and in form satisfactory to the Director of Law.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
