AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more contracts with West Creek Conservancy for the design and implementation of wetland mitigation projects for the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, the Director of Port Control desires to enter into one or more contracts with West Creek Conservancy ("West Creek") for the design and implementation of wetland mitigation projects that may include program management, land acquisition, remediation, mitigation coordination, monitoring, and other related services, for the Department of Port Control; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with West Creek for the design and implementation of wetland mitigation projects that may include program management, land acquisition, remediation, mitigation coordination, monitoring, and other related services, on the basis of its proposal dated October 2, 2025, for the Department of Port Control.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Port Control may sign all documents that are necessary to obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the consultants selected through that cooperative process. "The Director of Port Control shall provide written notice to the Clerk of Council whenever any purchase is made under this section, which notice shall include the details of any such cooperative purchases."

Section 3. That the cost of this ordinance shall not exceed \$2,700,000.00 and shall be paid from Fund Nos. 60 SF 001, 60 SF 141, and other funds approved by the Director of Finance. (RQS 3001, RLA 2025-45).

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
