

# Department of Port Control

Ordinance No.: 819-2024

## Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control (“Department”) is requesting authority to extend, and continue, the Lease by Way of Concession Agreements, between the various branded car rental companies that operate rental car concessions at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (“CLE”). The extension will be for a period of three (3) years with two (2) one-year options exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

All parties agree to extend the original agreements and any associated amendments, for the use and occupancy, of individual locations, for the ready return stalls and service centers.

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### **Background:**

Under the authority of Ordinance No. 1024-97, passed by the Council of the City of Cleveland on June 16, 1997, the City through its Director of Port Control, entered into multiple Lease Agreements with various branded car rental companies, for certain space at the Airport in the Rental Car Facility for the servicing, storing, and maintaining of rental vehicles.

The Department is requesting to extend the term by a period of three (3) years, with two one-year options to renew.
