**2026 Browns Stadium
Emergency Repairs**

Ordinance: XXX-2026

Description: The Huntington Bank Field is owned by the City of Cleveland and operated by the Cleveland Browns. Pursuant to the requirements of the lease of the stadium between the City of Cleveland and the Cleveland Browns dated October 23, 1998, in order to maintain the structure and to preserve its usefulness as a sports facility, this legislation will authorize the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects to reimburse the Cleveland Browns for the Emergency Repairs performed or cause to be performed by the Cleveland Browns for the improvements listed below for the Huntington Bank Field. These improvements have been reviewed, and physical conditions inspected by MOCAP and have been deemed to be necessary Emergency Repairs as defined in the Lease. Emergency Repairs have been limited to only those repairs that are essential to safely operating the stadium through the term of the lease.
